Preparing for Success in the World → Study in Philadelphia with Field Trips to Boston, New York, and Washington DC



English Plus (E+) Leadership is an academic bridge program designed to prepare non-native English speakers primarily educated in Korea for success in the world. The program has two goals: First, to enable participants to expand their thinking to better understand and describe complex problems.

Second, to apply appropriate thinking processes and solution strategies to address complex problems involving conflict between ideas and outcomes which can lead to physical and emotional harm. The program consists of three integrated courses/classes in which English language thinking, speaking, and writing are applied to personal and organizational challenges.

The program requires 12-15 instructional hours of activities per week for three weeks. The education activities will apply reading/vocabulary, writing/grammar, as well as listening/speaking skills to individual and organizational challenges.



Learning Themes

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Thematic / Thinking

Academic content and tasks addressing philosophy, history, politics, values, and life

Experiential

Assignments requiring contact with native speakers on the campus or through day trips, guest lectures, and social/cultural activities

Reflective

Reviewing how thinking and practices enable one to better understand and communicate with English speakers across the world

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Comprehend

to know something thoroughly and to perceive its relationships to certain other ideas, facts, etc.

Evaluate

to judge or calculate the quality, importance, amount, or value of something

Identify

to recognize or establish as being a particular person or thing

Explore

to look at (something) in a careful way to learn more about it to study or analyze (something)

Communicate

to give or interchange thoughts, feelings, information, or the like, by writing, speaking, etc.

Reflect

to give back or exhibit as an image, likeness, or outline
